



GFL ENVIRONMENTAL CORPORATE OVERVIEW

GFL Environmental, which takes its name from its corporate mission to be “green for life” is a diverse environmental services company with operations in Canada and the United States. GFL, founded in 2007, is a publicly traded company with the international headquarters in Vaughan, Ontario, with nearly 19,500 employees in the US and Canada. While the operations originated in Canada, in the US there are solid waste operations in over 37 states. In the state of North Carolina, we have approximately 2000 employees at 40 facilities across the state.

A major component of our business is residential and industrial waste management. Recognized by its signature fleet of bright green trucks and equipment, GFL proudly serves over 4 million households in communities across Canada and the United States with safe, reliable, and convenient curbside waste and recycling management.

Beyond residential waste management, GFL offers a wide range of waste management solutions including dumpster rentals, roll-off container services, and compactor services for businesses and industries, which can be tailored to meet customer needs. This allows GFL to provide solutions to a variety of service needs including a wide range of environmental and industrial services to businesses, commercial recycling, document shredding, liquid waste management including septic tank servicing, and infrastructure development including soil remediation, excavation, and demolition.

Across the US and Canada, GFL manages approximately 40 licensed, heavily regulated, municipal solid waste landfills. Landfills play a critical role in ensuring the environmentally responsible management of waste materials that cannot be recycled. Our landfills operate in strict compliance with all applicable environmental laws and regulations. Our modern landfills are highly engineered to include environmental protection technologies and sophisticated monitoring systems to protect soil and groundwater from impacts while limiting the release of landfill gas emissions and are being fitted with Renewable Natural Gas (RNG) facilities throughout the country. Our comprehensive safety and environmental management systems ensure the safe, sustainable and environmentally responsible management of all landfill operations.

GFL has invested heavily in landfill gas-to-energy technology that captures landfill gas and converts it to a green, renewable source of electricity and has formed a subsidiary - GFL Renewables. Today over 80% of GFL owned and operated municipal solid waste landfills have gas collection and treatment systems. We believe that the future of the waste industry will be to create sustainable solutions for customers' waste needs, including diverting as many waste streams as possible from landfills. We are working towards a more sustainable solution for all and our vision is to be *Green for Life*.
